**APPLY TO COMPLETE BROCK UNIVERSITY ACCOUNTING  
CONFERENCE (BUAC)**

BUAC is a conference / competition held at the beautiful Niagara Falls Hilton Hotel on November 18th to 20th. Edwards is looking to send one four person team to represent the college at this prestigious event. The team must consist of only accounting majors with two 4th year and two 3rd year students.

BUAC offers delegates the opportunity to expand their network by meeting with other peers, representatives from different accounting firms and distinguished guest speakers. In addition, delegates will learn the necessary soft and hard skills relevant to the theme of change by participating in numerous workshops and a challenging case competition. ## 2011-2012 SIFE Stock Market Challenge

The SIFE Stock Market Challenge is a six month stock trading

competition. Participants trade \$100,000 USD in "paper money" and attempt to earn the highest return and win cash prizes. This competition is a simulation of the stock market and is targeted towards all University students across campus. The SIFE Saskatchewan Stock Market Challenge teaches students the fundamentals of investing in the stock market in a risk-free environment and gives them exposure to the stock market world.

#### Basic Competition Details:

- Cash prizes awarded to top 4 portfolio values with over \$4,000 in cash prizes awarded in the past
- Cash prizes dependent on number of participants
- \$50 entry fee per team (maximum 2 participants per team)  
Participants must be a student enrolled at the University of Saskatchewan (undergraduate and post graduate)
- Entry fee includes registration to the stock trading simulation, admittance to the educational seminars focused on investment strategies, and 2 tickets to the Closing Bell ceremonies
- Investopedia platform will be used \$100,000 USD to trade in the US equity market.
- Competition begins October 11, 2011 and ceases March 9, 2012, at market close.
- Winners will be announced March 11, 2012 at Closing Bell ceremonies
- Resetting portfolio results in disqualification
- Disqualified teams are ineligible for prizes
